



UAMA Quran Recital Competition

Administrative Guidelines

1. There shall be 16 Surahs/chapters for the Quran Recital Competition.
2. The Surahs/Chapters for the Quran Recital Competition shall be selected by the Imams Committee.
3. Only **two** (2) Participants shall be registered to compete from each UAMA Chapter.
4. Participants shall be divided in two age groups; Children age 5 years to 12 years; and youths age 13 years to 17 years old.
5. All participants must be registered Conference attendees.
6. Substitution shall be allowed 24 hours before the event by contacting the Program Coordinator.
7. The Quran Recital competition will be held Friday and Saturday during the conference as scheduled; each participant is expected to compete in both days.
8. Participants have to be able to recite all the Surahs/chapters in the category given in both days to be eligible to win cash prizes.
9. Participants will be tested as follows: Memorization; Tajweed; and Fluency
10. There will be **four** (4) prizes; 2 winning positions for each age group, 1 winning position for boys and 1 position for girls. If the number of registrants for any level is less than 2, **ONLY** one winning position will be awarded.
11. The age of the participants within the group will be taken into account only as a tie breaker by the judges.
12. UAMA organizers reserves the right to dismiss, cancel and/or disqualify any contestant; this includes, but is not limited to, any participant who tampers with the operation of the competition or competition site or violates the terms and conditions, or any other applicable regulations.
13. Participants have no right to object, reject, or decline the judges' ruling; Judges' ruling will be final, but if participants have any concern they should address it within 3 days following the competition, to the head of the Judging Committee or the organizer.
14. Participants must agree to the terms and conditions by virtue of registration.
